

Evidence-Based Principles for Effective Interventions

Intermediate Measures for Monitoring Progress

1) Assessment

- A) Percentage of population with completed risk & needs assessment within time frame identified by policy.
- B) Percent of population with completed re-assessment within time frame identified by policy.
- C) Gain Score (changes in protective measure score as identified through re-assessment).

2) Case Plans

- A) Percentage of medium to high-risk offenders that have case plans developed within time frame identified by policy.
- B) Percentage of case plans that address the top 3 identified criminogenic needs according to the assessment.

3) Average length on supervision - sorted by risk level.

4) Revocations

- A) Number of technical violations resulting in revocation to jail.
- B) Number of technical violations resulting in revocation to prison.

5) Treatment

- A) Percentage of high-risk offenders referred to treatment.
- B) Percentage of high risk offenders that attended to treatment.
- C) Percentage of total population that attended treatment that are high-risk.
